Course Outline

Workplace injuries and deaths are a serious cause of concern in Australia. Due to the manner in which these statistics are recorded it is difficult to determine the number of deaths / injuries that occur in confined spaces in Australia. However, international statistics indicate that the majority of confined space fatalities result from unplanned rescue attempts.

RIIWHS202E Enter and Work in Confined Spaces is a nationally accredited one-day course (approximately 8 hours) that provides knowledge and skills for undertaking confined space work in a safe, controlled manner.

The course includes: Definition of Confined Spaces and Confined Space Entry; Planning the Work; Identifying Hazards and Controlling Risks; Common Hazards Associated with Confined Spaces; Control Measures for Working in Confined Spaces; Entering and Working in a Confined Space; Emergency Procedures; Clearing the Work Area.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites for enrolment in this course, however Enter and Work in Confined Spaces does require reading, writing and numeracy skills. 5th Point offers language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) support for all of our courses.

What to bring?

Please ensure that you wear suitable clothing for active movement. While our classrooms are fully air-conditioned, the training facility where practical training and assessment occurs can be hot in summer and very cool in winter, so please ensure you dress appropriately (layers are great!).

Long trousers and a long work shirt are the most appropriate as you will be entering and working within confined spaces as part of your training and assessment. Sturdy, enclosed footwear must be worn at all times. Work boots or steel-toe capped boots are not necessary.

All training materials and equipment are provided for the duration of your course.

Where are we?

We are located at 21 Old Pittwater Road, Brookvale in New South Wales. There is onsite parking available at the rear of the facility, with access off Green Street. Check us out on <u>Google Maps</u>.

Remember that training kicks off at 08:00 every morning, and will run through till 16:00. Breaks will be given throughout the day at the instructor's discretion.
